Volunteers can:

- Make friendly visits to patients/caregivers/spouse
- Take time to reminisce and share stories
- Play cards
- Read together (newspaper, magazine, book)
- Give wheelchair rides
- Stop by for coffee
- Write letters or future keepsake cards
- Provide haircuts
- Offer support and encouragement for caregivers
- Complementary therapy
 - Massage therapy
 - Reflexology
 - Reiki
- Paint fingernails
- Provide massage therapy
- Do light housekeeping
- Fix light meals
- Mow the lawn, rake leaves
- Take pets for a walk
- Play music
- Respite support, sitting with a patient so caregiver can have a break
- Pathway volunteers sit at the bedside of an actively dying patient

Volunteers Cannot:

- Administer medications
- Provide personal cares
- Feed patients
- Lift and transfer
- Take the place of concentrated care
